It is adjudged that

1. The Claimant recover against the Defendant the sum of £166.58 for debt and interest to date of judgment.

This sum comprises as follows:-

£80 - claim

£4.58 - interest

£25 - Court fee

Warning

If you ignore this order your goods may be removed and sold, or other enforcement proceedings may be taken against you. If this happens further costs will be added. If your circumstances change and you cannot pay, ask at the court office what you can do.

If judgment is for £5,000 or more, or is in respect of a debt which attracts contractual or statutory interest for late payment, the Claimant may be entitled to further interest.

How to Pay

2. **Reasons**

The Court acknowledged that the Defendant received papers on 26.8.2011. Nevertheless that allowed the Defendant some 6 days to read the Claimant's documents. A great many of the Claimant's documents were "generalised" and not relevant to this case. The Court notes that some of the evidence relied upon by the Claimant's had been made available to the Defendant's prior to issue of proceedings. District Judge Rand's order dated 23.6.2011 allows the Court a measure of discretion in determining whether documents served late can be relied upon.

The Court accepted the Claimant's evidence and found on a balance of probabilities that the claim was proved.

3. It is ordered that the Defendant pay to the Claimant the sum of £166.58 on or before 15 September 2011.
